

Reading Progress Test Instructions

- Have the RPT Student Response Forms ready for you to mark.
- Tell the student you are only counting correct answers, so they can:
 - Take a pass on any word.
 - Take a wild guess.
- For a PRETEST, show the student Page 1 and have the student read down the column.
- Put + on the Student Response Sheet if:
 - The word was read correctly. (If they give a response and then change their mind, ask for their final answer.)
 - o If they sound out the word but can snap it together to say it correctly.
- Put o on the Response Sheet if:
 - They are unable to give any response. (After a few seconds, tell them to try the next one.)
 - o They **give an incorrect response**. (Write what the student did say, if possible.)
- Go to Page 2 and repeat the steps, continuing until they have read six words in a row incorrectly.
- For a POST TEST, start on the page where they made their first error on the PRETEST. Start
 at the top of that column and continue as above.
- Mark the number of words correct for each page at the bottom of the list.
- For the percentage score, take the **total** number of words correct and divide by 180.
