



SPT Post-Test Instructions

- Check the student's pretest to see which levels were done previously.
- If they got 92% or higher, don't repeat that level.
- Don't use the words in sentences unless needed for clarification.
- Repeat the word as needed.
- Don't over-pronounce, just say it in a normal voice.
- Remind them that they can finger spell before you start the test but don't prompt them to as they proceed.
- Tell them they get partial credit so even if they only know part of the word, they should write that down.
- Tell them we just want to see if they know more words today than they did the last time we gave them these words.
- If they want to go back at the end to change their answer, that's fine.
- If they want to know which ones they got wrong, say that you can't tell them right now.
